As numbers of pupils taking a school lunch are at an all-time low, we are now very worried that we may lose this excellent provision. I am sure that you will join us in our determination to promote our school lunches, especially at a time when other schools are trying very hard to emulate what we already have here at Luckington (we are often approached for advice on our lunch arrangements). Mrs Hind, Mrs Luke, the school council pupils, and parent governors will be holding a meeting with staff from the Old Royal Ship on Tuesday 2nd June to look at the lunch menus and the present arrangements to see whether it is possible to find a way forward. We aim to come up with solutions that will clarify the needs & responsibilities of all parties involved and:

- Encourage the children to eat healthily by choosing a school lunch more often;
- Ensure that parents feel they are getting value for money;
- Ensure that the provision of our school lunches is viable to the Old Royal Ship;
- Address the compulsory government guidelines on nutrition and promoting healthy eating;

We will share the menu ideas already sent in by parents for Parents Forum meeting.
