## SCHOOL LUNCHES - CHANGES

Thank you very much for all your helpful comments and suggestions about school meals. It is great to hear that parents are so positive about keeping the current excellent provision. We have also been talking to the children and have been very impressed with their ideas. The main issue for the pub staff is that they need to have more notice of numbers taking lunch each day (and a minimum number to make it viable).

Helen and her staff are happy to make changes to the menu and we have attached the proposed 3-week menu which encompasses pupils' and parents' suggestions. We hope to start the new menu on 22<sup>nd</sup> June. Menus will now be put out on the website and notice board with dates to avoid confusion. We will be sending out a booking slip each Wednesday and will ask that you book your child's lunches for the following week by the Friday. This will make it much easier for the Ship staff and allow more choice. A vegetarian option (which has always been available on demand) can now be listed on the menu in advance. Lunches will still be paid on Monday morning and we must insist, please, that all lunch money is paid on time.

To make it fairer on those children having hot dinners (and healthier for all), we shall be insisting that all children have water with their meal, so packed lunch pupils will no longer be able to bring in alternative drinks. Water in jugs will be on the tables for all at lunchtime. Thank you for your support in keeping our hot meal provision. Many thanks to Helen and the staff at the Old Royal Ship for their willingness to work with us.

As you will know, we have some special lunch activities coming up, so please show your support and book your child in for these.

## New Teaching Assistant

With our admission numbers continuing to grow, we plan to appoint a permanent Teaching Assistant to work mainly in Class 1 every morning from September. The advertisement for this will shortly appear on the school website, in the local press and in the Wiltshire schools bulletin.

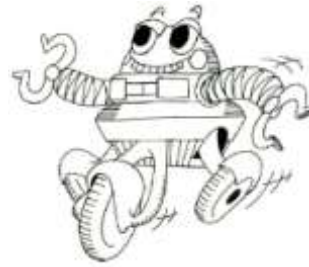
